This Sunday is Palm Sunday, the beginning of the Holy Week story that leads us through Jesus' final entry into Jerusalem and the events of the week leading up to the tragic moment of his death by execution, the silence of Holy Saturday, and the glory of resurrection on Easter Sunday.

I also want to lift up the "Seeking Question" for this Sunday, Palm Sunday. "Where are you headed?" Below is an excerpt of a poem from the Lenten Devotional we are using this season. I appreciate the poet's imagining of where we desire to be, and that moving in the direction of our hope and longing requires intentionality.
